



## Safe Internet Use Agreement for Secondary School children

1. I will **not** pretend to be doing my homework when really I am wasting time on other things on the computer like games or Facebook.
2. I understand that my parents expect to be able to check the internet history in my browser at any time, so they can see what websites I have been looking at.

3. I will tell my parents my internet password/s but will not give it/them out to anyone else (even my best friends).
4. I understand that Facebook can be seen by lots of friends and acquaintances so if I use it I will expect my parents to see what I have put on it (and will show them if asked).
5. If I see people doing things or saying things online I know they're not supposed to do or say and that could cause distress, I'll tell my parents.
6. If I watch something that is distressing or confusing I will tell my parents.
7. I will not fill out any form online that asks me for any information about myself or my family without checking with my parents first. This includes registering at a site. I will wait to do this with my parents.
8. I will check with my parents before downloading or installing software or doing anything that could possibly damage our computer.
9. I understand that is a privilege and not a right to have a mobile phone and that my parents (who pay for it) can take it and see what is on it at any time.
10. I will help my parents understand how easy it is to be entertained and have fun on the internet and generally explain how to do things with technology that they don't know but I do. 😊
